MUSIC THAT MAKES COMMUNITY is a movement in the church, rekindling an ancient practice of singing – a way of music making that has been central to folk traditions for centuries. It is simple and beautiful, faithful and traditional. Singing without the use of a book (or screens), rather relying on human to human communication, creates community in a powerful and unique way, transcending labels such as contemporary or traditional. This workshop will explore ways to incorporate this kind of singing into our regular liturgies, as well as stretching some boundaries. A wide variety of music will be sung and basic techniques for leading will be introduced.



Our presenter will be **Scott Weidler** who has served the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America as Associate Director for Worship and Music since 1995. He is ELCA liaison to the national board of the Leadership Program for Musicians (LPM), as well as having served on the boards of the Institute of Liturgical Studies at Valparaiso University and the Lutheran Music Program. He is a regular presenter with the ecumenical **Music that Makes Community** project. He is also Cantor at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Chicago. Scott has earned degrees in education, music, and liturgy from Concordia College, Seward, Nebraska, Wittenberg University, Springfield, Ohio, and the University of Notre Dame. He resides in the Rogers Park neighborhood on Chicago's north side with his partner, Zia Ahmad.
